
## **Entering The California Science Center**



People get to the science center in different ways. Some people drive in a car, take a bus, or ride the train. How will I get there?







things.






The rotunda may be quiet, or it may be loud. If it is crowded, I will do my best to stay close to the people I came with.






When I am ready **to go inside**, I can walk through the sliding-glass doors into the museum.






Inside, I will see the Information Desk and the ExploraStore gift shop. If I keep walking straight, I will see the food court.
